

1st Classical Music Festival “THE RETURN” for composers up to 20 years old

December 26, 2023 at 5.00 pm
Philharmonic Hall – Corso Rosmini 86 Rovereto

Regulation:

1. Conditions: young composers up to 20 years of age who personally perform their own classical music pieces are admitted. An instrumental skill level of at least 5th grade is required. A letter of introduction from the teacher is welcome, but not mandatory. Compositions that do not appear to be original works composed by the candidate will be disqualified.
2. Instruments (solo): piano – violin – viola – cello – oboe – clarinet - saxophone - guitar.
3. Duration of the performance: from 3 to 15 minutes (one or more compositions can be performed).
4. How to participate: send the full video LINK of the composition/s (downloadable) performed by the composer together with your CV to **mozart.malta@gmail.com** by **30 October 2023** indicating "The Return 2023" as the object. In case of selection you will be asked to fill in a registration form and pay the participation fee of €50, to be paid to APS Grande Quercia by 10 November 2023. The participation fee will not be refunded, excluding the case of cancellation of the event.
5. Admission: the Artistic Direction will select among the candidates those who will be admitted to the Festival according to its unquestionable judgment.
6. Recognitions: at the end of the performance each participant will be given a "Certificate of Participation"
7. Stay and board: organization and expenses are the responsibility of each participant.
8. Authorizations: the Festival participants (or their parents in the case of minors) authorize the Organizers to disseminate photo/audio/video/TV footage material of the event on Youtube, social networks, websites, radio and means of communication which may be used for promotional purposes only.
9. Ownership and copyright: The Organizers retain ownership of the materials sent during the selection phase and any photos/audio/video/TV footage of the event and will archive them in the Associations' Music Archive, without prejudice to the fact that the authors hold the copyright. Participants in the Festival (or their parents in the case of minors) will renounce in writing the payment of copyright on the music they perform during the Festival.
10. Privacy: the personal data of the participants will be used for the sole purpose of organizing the Festival, as per the Privacy law in force in Italy.
11. Participants in "The Return 2023" Festival accept this regulation in its entirety, unconditionally and in full.
12. In the event of a dispute, the official text of these Regulations in Italian will prevail.
